## Growing tobacco and creating a cigar



There is very little doubt about where tobacco was grown for the first time. The native peoples of the American continent were definitely the first people to cultivate and smoke the tobacco plant. Until the voyage of discovery of Christopher Columbus in 1492, tobacco was unknown to the rest of the world. On their return the Conquistadors brought the plant back to Portugal and Spain. Initially, the practice of smoking only spread from Spain to the residencies of gentry and royalty. Cigars were produced with Cuban tobacco in Seville ("Sevillas") from 1717.
